### **KILMONEY DOES IT AGAIN**

Kilmoney Cottage Stud made further pinhooking profits, following the success of their Poet's Voice colt mentioned in yesterday's issue, when their Motivator filly, Lot 211, was sold for 160,000gns to Anthony Stroud, who was acting on behalf of The Cool Silk Partnership.

The May-born filly, who was signed for by Peter and Ross Doyle at last year's December Sale for 38,000gns, enjoyed a recent catalogue update when Move In Time landed Sunday's Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye.

#### **BEST OF AMERICAN AND EUROPEAN**

Barbara Facchino's Barouche Stud brought over some of the best American blood in the form of an unraced fullsister to Tapit to mix with some of the best European blood, by covering her with Galileo. The resultant offspring, an April-born colt (Lot 212) realised 400,000gns yesterday when selling to American Shawn Dugan.

Facchino purchased Tapit's dam, Tap Your Heels, when the Gainesway sire was just a yearling for \$900,000 at Keeneland in 2002 and the mare remains in the US. Stud Manager Rory Matthews confirmed that she has an Elusive Quality filly foal at foot, that her Medaglia D'Oro yearling filly was sold at Keeneland for \$400,000 and that
